



Charles Burchfield was an avid journal writer. We will keep a journal for one week.

In the journal you will need to include the following information:

## **Weather**

Track the morning and evening outdoor temperature. Once you have collected your data, it will need to be graphed. You should also record your impressions of the daily weather. How does it make you feel? Sad, happy, or lonely? You may also include any other information about the weather that you would think is important—for example, “The day started out sunny and bright, but by the end it was windy, rainy and bitter cold.”

## **Music**

Burchfield loved music. In your research, you have discovered several works or composers he liked to listen to when he did his art. Listen to one of the composers. In your journal describe your impressions of the music. How does it make you feel?

## **Art**

Choose two paintings from your research. Write a comparison of the two paintings in your journal. What are similarities? What are differences? In what season were they painted? Are there any symbols that might represent something real? Are there any animals or people in the paintings? What are the titles? Do the titles tell the feeling of the painting?
