



Instructions:

Compose an eight-measure melodic composition in 4/4 time using the following criteria:

- ___ 1. Treble clef is accurately drawn at the beginning of each line of the composition.
 - ___ 2. Time signature (4/4) is at the beginning of the first staff line.
 - ___ 3. Composition begins on Middle C.
 - ___ 4. Composition ends on Middle C.
 - ___ 5. Composition ends on a leading tone (D to Middle C or G to Middle C).
 - ___ 6. Composition stays within the interval of a fifth (Middle C to G).
 - ___ 7. Only one jump of a fifth is used.
 - ___ 8. A tie between two of the same notes is used.
 - ___ 9. Syncopation is used.
 - ___ 10. Quarter note is used.
 - ___ 11. Half note is used.
 - ___ 12. Dotted quarter to eighth note is used.
 - ___ 13. All eight measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 14. Seven measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 15. Six measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 16. Five measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 17. Four measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 18. Three measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 19. Two measures contain four beats.
 - ___ 20. One measure contains four beats.
