2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The story is incomplete but has some development.• The story tries to anticipate the audience's needs.• Most of the story shows little use of correct spelling, punctuation, and capitalization.
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The story is incomplete and is not developed.• The story does not anticipate the audience's needs.• The story shows little or no use of correct spelling, punctuation, and capitalization.
