



sod house: pioneer's house, in which walls were built with stacked layers of turf

tableau: a dramatic convention in which individuals use their bodies to create a frozen scene that expresses actions, locations, feelings or situations

log cabin: pioneer's house made from logs that came from clearing land for settlement

covered wagon: wagon covered by a canvas top; a common form of transportation in the 18th and early 19th century

stagecoach: a coach pulled by horses that runs and stops on a regular schedule; mail was often delivered on this coach in early U.S. settlements
