



assumption: An idea that is taken to be true without checking or proving it

categorize: To put similar or like items into a group

category: A class or group of things that has something in common

collage: Creating or taking separate items and placing them together in a composition on a surface, such as paper, canvas, or screen

discrimination: Unfair or unjust behavior toward others based on differences in age, race, gender, religion, etc.

gender: The sex of a person

label: A word or phrase that describes or identifies something

prejudice: A fixed, unreasonable, or unfair opinion about someone based on the person's race, religion, or other characteristic

racism: Discrimination or prejudice based on race, such as the belief that a particular race is superior to others

represent: To stand for or symbolize something

sexism: Discrimination or prejudice based on one's sex; For example, assuming that girls can't play football or that boys can't sew, are examples of sexism.

stereotype: An overly simple description or opinion about a person, group, or thing, without regard to the individual.
