

Fables: Reading a Fable

fable: a fictitious story meant to teach a lesson. The characters in fables are usually animals

improvisation: to perform, write, dance, or sing on the spur of the moment without any preparation; to use the tools at hand to fulfill an unforeseen and immediate need

portray: to make a picture of someone or something using words

genre: a type of literature

flattery: excessive compliments, insincere praise, exaggerated attention

intimidation: making someone afraid or fearful by threatening them
